## 4. Discretionary Funding Application Reviews 10:21-50:47

Committee members with active applications, City of Medford and Jackson County, mentioned they were flexible on fund-types for their projects, STBG vs. CMAQ, so that all projects could be funded.

Agenda item included discussions that leftover discretionary funding money could be made available for the Oregon Household Activity Survey. Staff also suggested that some MPO PL funds could be set aside for a few years for extra survey funding.

Justin Shoemaker commented that the PE estimates on all the projects seem too low and should be revised by the jurisdictions that applied. Staff recommended jurisdictions work with Mr. Shoemaker to correct estimates to more accurate levels of cost.

Staff reminded the RVMPO TAC that they will be scoring the project applications. Scoring sheet to be sent out ahead of time so committee members can review applications and score them before the next meeting if they prefer.
