The City would expect to have to compete for funding over the course of 10-12+ years in order to amass the estimated \$10M+ for planning, design, engineering, ROW acquisition, and construction. The City is no longer interested in pursuing that path at this time. Instead, a alternative project Shasta Ave & East Main St Sidewalk upgrades is now requested.
