A. Add Project to TIP: Diesel and CNG Bus Fleet Replacement - FFY 2023 RVTD 5339(b) (KN 23566)

Description: Purchase of six accessible low floor, Clean Air Act (CAA) compliant, Diesel-Electric Hybrid buses to replace 3 Diesel buses and 3 CNG buses that are past their useful life. Project is funded using FFY 2023 FTA 5339(b) Bus and Bus Facilities program funds to maintain a state of good repair and reliable transit service in the RVTD service area.

The City prefers to use its grant funding to do Shasta Ave & East Main St Sidewalk Upgrade instead of the original project. The original project, the current grant would be the first several phases. The City would expect to have to compete for funding over the course of 10-12+ years in order to amass the estimated \$10M+ for planning, design, engineering, ROW acquisition, and construction. The City is no longer interested in pursuing that path at this time. Instead, a alternative project Shasta Ave & East Main St Sidewalk upgrades is now requested.
