## AMENDMENT NUMBER 02 INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

## ODOT/MPO/Public Transportation Providers Agreement Metropolitan Planning, Financial Plans and Obligated Project Lists

Rogue Valley Metropolitan Planning Organization Rogue Valley Transportation District

This is Amendment No. 02 to the Agreement between the STATE OF OREGON, acting by and through its Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as "ODOT," and the ROGUE VALLEY METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION, acting by and through its Policy Committee, hereinafter referred to as "MPO" and ROGUE VALLEY TRANSPORTATION DISTRICT, acting by and through its Board of Directors, hereinafter referred to as "Public Transportation Provider," all hereinafter referred to individually as "Party" or "Agency" and collectively as "Parties," entered into on July 17, 2018 and Amendment 01 on February 12, 2025.

It has now been determined by the Parties that the Agreement referenced above shall be amended to extend the termination date.

**1.** <u>Effective Date.</u> This Amendment shall become effective on the date it is fully executed and approved as required by applicable law.

### 2. Amendment to Agreement.

### Section 1. TERMS OF AGREEMENT, Paragraph 3, Page 2, which reads:

3. The term of this Agreement shall begin on the date all required signatures are obtained. The work identified in Section 1, Paragraph 1 shall be completed no later than November 30, 2025, on which date this Agreement terminates unless extended by an executed amendment to this Agreement.

### Shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

- 3. The term of this Agreement shall begin on the date all required signatures are obtained. The work identified in Section 1, Paragraph 1 shall be completed no later than November 30, 2030, on which date this Agreement terminates unless extended by an executed amendment to this Agreement.
- **3.** <u>Counterparts.</u> This Amendment may be executed in two or more counterparts (by facsimile or otherwise) each of which is an original and all of which when taken together are deemed one agreement binding on the Parties, notwithstanding that all Parties are not signatories to the same counterpart.
- **4.** <u>Original Agreement</u>. Except as expressly amended above, all other terms and conditions of the original Agreement are still in full force and effect. The Parties certify that the

representations, warranties and certifications in the original Agreement are true and correct as of the effective date of this Amendment and with the same effect as though made at the time of this Amendment.

5. Electronic Signatures. ODOT reserves the right at any time to require the submission of the hard copy originals of any documents.

THE PARTIES, by execution of this Agreement, hereby acknowledge that their signing representatives have read this Agreement, understand it, and agree to be bound by its terms and conditions.
